(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said W. B. Harrison, his heirs executors and administrators four lots Nos. 94, Block E, North side of Washington Road fronting on said road fifty (50) feet and lots Nos. 100, 105, 106 on the South side of Upper Avenue, Block E, fronting said Avenue fifty (50) feet each, Survey of East Pacific, Royalton Addition to Greenville, S. C. being an addition of the same lots conveyed to us by T. F. Huber as Trustee, by deed dated October 2d, 1911 and recorded in Volume 7, page 352, Office of Register of Deeds Conveyance of Greenville County. Said lots being in the city of Greenville and County aforesaid. (Upon condition, however, which is as follows off the consideration of this deed, that the purchaser know his grantee be granted, heirs or assigns shall not sell, rent or otherwise dispose of the above described property to a person or persons of African descent, to which condition hereby is declared to be a condition subsequent.)

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said W. B. Harrison, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we do hereby bind our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said W. B. Harrison, his heirs and assigns, against us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming to claim the same, or any part thereof.
