NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. H. T. Henderson of Greenville, in the State aforesaid
City, in consideration of the sum of ten dollars and other valuable consideration DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by J. A. Cox.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. A. Cox, his heirs and assigns: All that lot of land
 situate on the East side of Tay Street, in the City and
 County of Greenville, South Carolina, and being lot No.
 1 in block 6, as shown on plat of Boyce Addition, re-
 corded in plat book 6, page 179 Beginning at a stake
 on the corner of a ten foot alley and Tay Street; thence to
long Tay St. S. 5° E 70 feet to an iron pin. Whence N. 76.45° E 200 ft.
to an iron pin, thence N. 15° W 70 feet to an iron pin on the
south side of said ten foot alley; thence along said
alley N. 76.45° W 200 feet to the beginning corner, being one
 of the lots of land conveyed to me by Louise Division,
May the 4th nineteen hundred and sixteen recorded
