NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That L. M. H. Harris in the State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of One hundred and Sixty Five DOLLARS, to 228 in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by L. M. H. Harris

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Lillie R. Harris, all that piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being situated in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville on the Eastley Bridge Road, about two and one half miles from the City of Greenville, and having the following streets and bounds, beginning at the corner of Graceland Cemetery and Washington Avenue and running thence, N. 73° 30' E. 185' to an iron post, thence, S. 22° 10' E. 65' to an iron post, thence, S. 71° W. 185' to an iron post, and thence 50 feet west along said Washington Avenue to beginning corner.

Also one other piece, parcel or lot of land, lying and being situated in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville on the Eastley Bridge Road about two and one half miles from the City of Greenville, and having the following streets and bounds: Beginning at a point on the said, Washington Avenue, 380 feet from said corner of Graceland Cemetery and running thence, N. 71° E. 200' to an iron post, thence S. 22° 10' E. 80' to an iron post, thence S. 71° W. 200' to an iron post on Washington Avenue, thence along with said Washington Avenue 50' feet to the beginning corner.
