(hereinbelow whereof is hereinafter acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Emma S. Bright, a certain parcel or piece of land situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid containing twenty acres more or less lying on South Tyger River, it being a part of the George Dill place Commencing at a stone on the bank of South Tyger River, corner on the West side of a drain ditch running on the West side of said Ditch to the table land the uses with said hill to the Camp Creek road to a stone on the South side of said road on the eastern boundary line, thence a South east direction with said road to a stone thence a South direction to Wild Cat Creek to a stone, thence with the meanders of said Creek to the river, thence up said river to the beginning corner.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said Emma S. Bright her heirs and assigns, forever.
