 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by B. O. Woodward

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said B. O. Woodward his heirs and assigns, All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville in Grove Township, at or near Golden Grove and containing three (3) acres, more or less; this being the same land conveyed to me by Walter M. Scott, Judge of Robt., by deed dated 10th. day of February 1917, and recorded in the S. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Volume # 18 of Deeds at page 502; see also Deed Book # 7 at page 856.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said B. O. Woodward, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said B. O. Woodward, his heirs and assigns, against myself and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
