NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That J. H. S. Brockman
in consideration of the sum of Ten and No/100 Dollars and other ^{in the State aforesaid} considerations
to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by
J. H. Brockman

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. H. Brockman all that piece parcel or lot of land situate
in the County and State aforesaid, a short distance outside
of the City of Greenville, represented on a plat made by W. R.
Punchney Surveyor, in December 1913, as lots Nos. 1 and 2
of the land of H. W. Mowbray and Burgess; said lots lying to-
gether and constituting one body, and lying south of a new
road, or street, leading to Greenville. Lot No. 1 has the following lines:
Beginning at a stake, southeast corner of two roads, thence with
the road leading to Greenville South 44.30 E. 191 feet to corner of Lot No. 12
thence S. 37. W. 230 feet to a stake, corner of lots 1, 2, 10 and 11;
thence with line of lot No. 11 N. 44 1/2 W. to stake on road; thence
with road N. 35 E. 230 feet to the beginning. Lot No. 2 has the
following lines: Beginning at a stake on road leading
to Greenville, corner of Lot No. 1; thence with said road S. 44-30
E. 191 feet to a stake, corner of said road and another road
thence with last mentioned road S. 33. W. 230 feet to stake
corner of lot No. 10; thence with line of lot No. 10 N. 44 1/2 W. to
stake corner of lots Nos. 10, 11, and 1; thence with line of lot
No. 1. N. 35 E. 230 feet to the beginning.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular, the said premises before mentioned unto the said
J. H. Brockman his heirs and assigns, forever.

forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said
J. H. Brockman, his heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against
every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
