NOW KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *J. B. Marshall* in the State aforesaid  
 in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand DOLLARS,  
 to be paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *J. B. Marshall*.

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said *J. B. Marshall*, his heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate within the corporate limits of the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, and described as follows: Beginning at a stake on the North side of Davy Street, corner J. N. Davidson's corner, and runs thence with said street S. 18° 5' E. 85 1/2 feet to stake on right of Way due to Charlotte Fire Line Railings; thence with said right of Way N. 20° 4' E. 209.4 feet to a stake; thence N. 18° 4' E. 52 feet to a stake on same line Davidson's lot; thence with his line 209.4 feet to his corner, containing 4 1/10 acre, more or less, and will be set off six more land conveyed by *J. B. Speights* to me in deed dated the 30th day of December, 1909, and recorded in Vol. 48 P. 4, 17.

Also all that lot of land adjoining above described tract and being described as follows: Beginning at a stake on Davy St. corner of Mrs. Alice Ferguson's lot and runs thence N. 18° 4' E. 104.7 feet to a stake on said Davy Street; thence N. 75° E. 209.4 feet to a stake; thence S. 18° 5' E. 104.7 feet to a stake in Mrs. Ferguson's line; the acre of 7 3/4, 209.4 feet to the beginning corner, containing one-half acre, more or less, and conveyed to me by *J.
