NOW, KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

in consideration of the sum of *One thousand dollars* DOLLARS
to *the* in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by *W. H. G. Parish*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. H. G. Parish, all that lot of land situate on the East side of Main Street between Carrier Street and Store Avenue, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, having a frontage of sixty (60) feet on Main Street and running back from Main Street in parallel lines, two hundred and ten (210) feet, or less, to an alley, bounded on the east by *John W. Arnold* and on the south by *J. Thomas Arnold* and on the west by Main Street.
 Also all that lot or strip of land situate on the east side of South Main Street, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning on said Street at the corner of lot formerly owned by *John W. Arnold* and running, thence with line of that lot N. 70 1/2 E Two hundred and ten feet more or less to an alley; thence along the alley toward carrier street, twelve (12) feet; thence in a straight line to main street, two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less to a point on said street twelve (12) feet, from the beginning, concrethence with said street twelve feet to the beginning, corry.
