 in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars and four cents DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by W. G. Parrish

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these Presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

W. G. Parrish, all that lot of land situate on the East side of Main Street between Carrier Street and Store Avenue, in the City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, having a frontage of sixty (60) feet on Main Street and running back from Main Street in parallel lines two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less, to an alley bounded on the east by lands formerly belonging to W. G. Parrish and on the west by Main Street

Also all that lot or strip of land situate on the east side of South Main Street in the City, and County of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning on said Street at the corner of lot formerly owned by Allen S. Donald, and running thence with and of that lot N. 70 to E Two hundred and ten feet more or less to an alley; thence along the alley toward Carrier Street, twelve (12) feet; thence in a straight line to main Street two hundred and ten (210) feet, more or less to a point on said street twelve (12) feet from the beginning; thence with said street twelve feet to the beginning, county.

heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
