KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Me, Ida L. Willson, Louise A. Leonard, Bessie L. Todd, Tallulah L. Cudd, Leonora L. Brigggs, and Oliver W. Leonard, (heirs at law and devisees of J.D. Leonard, deceased) in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of One dollar and division of property DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Roy E. Leonard

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Roy E. Leonard, all that lot or tract of land situated, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State aforesaid, on the North side of Gilder's Creek, being a part of the land bought by J.D. Leonard from J. Thomas Austin, March 18th, 1886, known as the Austin Place, Recorded in Book "RR", page 626:

us and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
