KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Blanche E. Thomason of the City and County of Greenville and

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

Thirteen Hundred and fifty and 00/100 DOLLARS,

to me in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by Mrs. Anna Gilmer

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Mrs. Anna Gilmer, her heirs and assigns forever: All those certain pieces, parcels and lots of land situated lying and being in the 5th Ward of the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville and State aforesaid on the North side of Rhett Street and having the following metes and bounds, to wit: The first or larger lot beginning at an iron pin 3 1/2 on said Rhett Street 100 feet from corner of Rhett and Mackley Streets and running thence along said Rhett Street N. 70 1/2 E. 96 feet to an iron pin 3 1/2, Celeje's corner; thence with Celeje's line N. 19 1/2 W. 64 feet to an iron pin 3 1/2, Mrs. Lindsey's corner; thence with her line S. 71 W. 95 feet to an iron pin 3 1/2; thence S. 18 1/2 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner, and containing 6160 sq. feet, more or less.

The other parcel or lot of land embraces a small strip next adjoining the above described lot on the West, having the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin 3 1/2 on Rhett Street and running thence with said Street N. 70 1/2 E. 4 feet to an iron pin 3 1/2 corner of first described lot; thence with line of said lot N. 18 1/2 W. 65 feet to an iron pin 3 1/2, on Mrs. Lindsey's line; thence with her line S. 71 W. 4 feet to an iron pin 3 1/2, Mrs. P. McHugh's corner; thence with her line S. 18 1/2 E. 65 feet to the beginning corner. The two described lots fronting one lot containing 6420 sq. feet, more or less, and being the same lots conveyed to me and W. J. Thomason by Wm. B. Bolt by Deed dated July 21st, 1912 and recorded in R. M. C. office for said County in Book Vol. 17 at page 462 and to me by W. J. Thomason by Deed, for his interest, dated Jan. 1st, 1917, which Deed is recorded in R. M. C. office for said County in Book Vol. 36 at page 155.
