(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. D. White, and his heirs and assigns, an undivided one-third $\frac{1}{3}$ interest of in and to all that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville on Laurel Creek, waters of Rocky River, and known as Tract #4 of the Stephen Huffish Estate, having the following meter and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone 37, corner T. D. Donaldson land and running thence N. 46. 20. 70; thence N. 82 W. 3. 50; thence N. 11-1/4 W. 24. 80 to stone 37; thence N. 72 W. 9. 70 to stone; thence S. 1-1/2 E. 50. 50 to stone 37; thence N. 84 E. 15. 20 the beginning corner, and containing fifty-seven (57) acres, more or less; this being the same land conveyed to me by Susan White by Deed dated 12th day of July, 1906 and recorded in the R.
