KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, M. L. Cox of Oconee County

in the State aforesaid,  
in consideration of the sum of  
Eighteen (\$1800.00) hundred  
DOLLARS,

at and before the sealing of these presents by William G. Vance, Greenville County

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

William G. Vance, his heirs and assigns forever:  
All that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated  
lying and being in Dunklin Township on the waters  
of Horse Creek containing Sixty (60) Four acres more  
or less and being tract #1 of the Horse Creek planta-  
tion belonging to the estate of the late F. M. Davenport  
and being represented by a plat made by James  
P. Willis Surveyor, and has the following trustee  
and bounds to wit: Beginning at a stone in the  
forks of the road near where Alex Chapman now  
lives; thence S. 36° E. 6.68 chains to a stone; thence  
S. 88½ E. 6.70 chains to a stone; thence N. 87 E.  
25 chains to a stone 34; thence N. 52 1/2 E. 30 chains  
crossing a small branch, to a stone at the inter-  
section of branch with Horse Creek 34; thence up
