 KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Lucy B. Hindman

in the State aforesaid,
 in consideration of the sum of
Eighteen Hundred Seventy-five ^{20/100} DOLLARS,
 to me in hand paid
 at and before the sealing of these presents by James McCroskey and Lillian L. McCroskey

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said James McCroskey and Lillian L. McCroskey, their heirs and assigns forever: All those three (3) certain lots of land lying being land situate in Chick Springs Township in the County of Greenville in the State of South Carolina, known and designated as lots numbered Six, Seven and Eight (6, 7 & 8) of Block "A" as shown by plat made August 1917 by F. E. Dalton, Engineer, of that certain property known as "Highland Terrace". For source of title to said property reference is invited to Deed of Conveyance to me by W. P. Meese, W. P. Conyers and W. J. Henderson, Trustees recorded in Deed Book 40 at page 248 in the office of W. H. C. for Greenville County. This Deed of Conveyance is made and accepted upon the express understanding and agreements as follows to wit: 1st. That the property is not to be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to persons of African descent. 2nd. That no negroes and ardent spirits are to be sold on the property. 3rd. That no use shall be made of the said lots, or any part thereof which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of any of the neighboring lots. 4th. That no dwelling house shall be built on any of said lots to cost less than Two Thousand Dollars, but one or more lots may be used for placing one residence thereon. 5th. That no building shall be erected nearer the street than the building line of Twenty One (21) feet from street on which said lots face. 6th. These conditions shall be effective and hold good for the period of twenty-one years from the date of this conveyance.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining,
 TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said James Lillian L. McCroskey, their
 heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I do hereby bind
 heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said James Lillian L. McCroskey, their
 heirs and assigns, against
 and
 heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
