at and before the sealing of these presents by J. C. Milford

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

J. C. Milford his heirs and assigns forever:  
All those two pieces, parcels and lots of land, situate in the County and State aforesaid and within the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, in Ward No. 6, lying on the northern side of Sullivan Street, and having the following meters and bounds and courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Sullivan Street, where said lot corners on an alley and running thence N. 14 E. 148'-0" to iron pin, thence N. 77 1/2 W. 92'-0" to iron pin, thence S. 1/4 W. 160'-0" to iron pin on Sullivan Street, thence along Sullivan Street S. 88 3/4 E. 59'-0" to the beginning corner, ~~also~~ all that piece, parcel and lot of land situate in the State, City and County and Ward aforesaid, having the following meters and bounds and courses and distances to-wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Sullivan Street, corner of lot of myself (C.
