(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Frances W. Latham, her heirs and assigns forever, All of our right, title and interest of every kind to and in all of that certain piece, parcel and tract of land situated in Greenville County and State aforesaid, adjoining lands of Mrs. Beattie and Lots No. 6 in the division of the real estate of the late Z.B. Watkins, as shown on a plat and survey made by W.A. Adams, Surveyor and known as tract number five on the above mentioned plat, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on stake on Mrs. Beattie's line corner of lot No. 6, and thence with said line N. 30-3/8 W. 10.50 to stone 3Xom; thence S. 83 W. 6.00 to stone; thence S. 86 W. crossing G. & W. Railway 5.00 to iron pin in road; thence with said road as the line 20.59 to stake on west side of road; thence N. 41-1/4 E. 5.30 to stone; thence S. 59-1/2 E. 10.38 to stone; thence S. 15 E. 5.30 to stake in road; thence S. 36-1/8 E. 10.50 to iron pin in road; thence S. 48-3/4 W. 16.37 to the beginning, containing thirty seven and 50/100 acres, more or less; This deed is to take the place of a former one filed in Vol. 50, page 256 through error in witnessing.

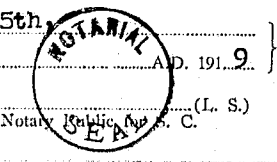

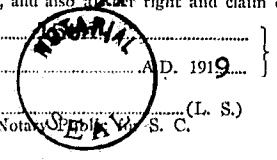
