(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Lucy D. Kindman and Lelou Gillespie their heirs and assigns: All that tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Greenville, in the said State, and has the following metes and bounds, to wit: Beginning at a stone 3x4 (in place of a stake) at N. 16° Wards corner and running thence N. 59 3/4 E. 28.40 to a stone 3x4 by a large black Oak; thence N. 26 1/2 W. 12.37 to a stone 3x4. thence S. 63 1/4 W. 12.34 to a pine stump 3x4; thence N. 27.1 W. 43.90 to a stone 3x4; thence S. 63 1/4 W. 17.61 to a post oak 3x4; thence S. 28 1/2 E. 58.14 to the beginning corner, Adjoining lands of Brown Estate, Howard and others, and containing one hundred and eleven and three fourths (111 3/4) acres more or less and being the same land conveyed to us by H. A. Myrick, by deed dated April 5th 1919 and recorded in the R. M. O. Office for Greenville County in Book 44 page 482, for a sum of the consideration of this deed the grantee herein hereby assume and will pay so much of the mortgage indebtedness now on the above described property as amounts to Four Thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars, together with any interest that may accrue thereon according to the terms of the note which said mortgage secures from and after January the first 1919, which is excepted from the general warranty herein after expressed.
