(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

C. H. Stokes, All that certain lot of land situate on the West side of Rowley Street, City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pin 317 feet from the Northwest corner of Carver and Rowley Streets, and running thence with Rowley Street N. 20-19 E. 58 1/2 feet to an iron pin thence N. 77 W. 207 feet 4 1/2 inches to an iron pin on an eighteen foot alley, thence S. 20-19 W. 58 1/2 feet to an iron pin, thence S. 77 E. about 206 1/2 feet to the beginning corner, a one-fourth interest in said lot being inherited by me from Emma J. Howell and the remaining three-fourths interest being conveyed to me by Robert W. Howell et al. by deed dated February 4, 1913, and recorded in Vol. 24, page 258, R. M. C.
