KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That *Columbus L. Farmer* of *Spotsylvania*,

in the State aforesaid,

in consideration of the sum of

One thousand and Sixty five (\$1,065.00) DOLLARS,

to *John J. Wood* in hand paid

at and before the sealing of these presents by *John J. Wood*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

John J. Wood, all those two pieces, parcels and lots of land, situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, on South side of Tugaloos Road, No. 1. Beginning at a stone 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ on J. H. Rose's line, thence N. 40° 4' W. 4.16 chel. to a stone in the Tugaloos road; thence along said road S. 45° 2' W. 3.33 chel. to a stone in Road; thence S. 40° 2' E. 3.97 chel. to a stone on J. H. Rose's line; thence along said line N. 49° 4' E. 3.33 chel. to the beginning and containing 1.35 acres more or less; see deed bearing date 12th day of November 1894, recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book B. B. B. page 42, for more complete description to above lot of land.

M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book B. B. B. page 726, for more complete description to the above lot of land; and being the same two tracts of land conveyed to *John C. Farmer*, deceased, by *Will C. Nol*, by deed, dated October 21st, 1911, and recorded in R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Volume 15 page 553.
