Lizzie Golightly, her heirs and assigns, all those certain pieces, parcels and lots of land situate, lying and being in the State and County aforesaid, in the County of Greenville near Furman University, and being a portion of the land owned by Samuel B. M. Daniel at the time of his death, and being known and designated as lots #2, 3 and 4 of the estate of Samuel B. M. Daniel deceased, according to a survey and plat thereof made by R. C.
