

W. D. Parrish et al DEED TO Willie Cooley Belk

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We W. D. Parrish and J. C. Gowers of the City of Greenville

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Fifteen Hundred (\$1500.00) DOLLARS, to us in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Willie Cooley Belk

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

Willie Cooley Belk, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being in the County and State aforesaid just without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the East side of Augusta Road known and designated as lot No. 4, as shown on plat of property of Parrish & Gowers by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, dated May 1919 and having the following metes and bounds to-wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on Augusta Road 435.3 feet from the intersection of Augusta Street and Prentiss Avenue joint corner of lots Nos. 3 and 4, and running thence along line of lot No. 3, N. 42-07 E. 165.4 feet to an iron pipe on a 15 foot alley; thence with said alley S. 53-03 E. 60.2 feet to an iron pipe joint corner lots Nos. 4 and 5; thence with line of lot No. 5, S. 42-07 W. 170.7 feet to an iron pipe on Augusta Road; thence with Augusta Road N. 47-53 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning. This being a portion of the land conveyed to us by Cagle Park Company by Deed dated May 26th 1919. Subject however to the following restrictions, which are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on the plat above referred to, which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years from the date of this deed, to-wit: (1) The property herein conveyed nor any part thereof shall not be sold, rented or otherwise disposed of to negroes. (2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business nor for anything which should constitute a nuisance. (3) The property herein conveyed shall not be rent nor sub-divided so as to face any other direction than as shown on said plat. (4) No building shall be erected upon said property within thirty-five feet of the present line of Augusta Street. (5) No building costing less than four thousand (\$4000.00) Dollars shall be erected upon said lot, other than outbuildings appurtenant to dwelling.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Willie Cooley Belk, her heirs and assigns, forever.

AND We ourselves and our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Willie Cooley Belk, her heirs and assigns, against our selves and heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
