KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That William Goldsmith, W. H. Workman and Walter W. Goldsmith,

in the State aforesaid,
for \$10 Dollars and other valuable consideration, DOWERS,
to C. L. in hand paid
at and before the sealing of these presents by P. F. Coyle

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

P. F. Coyle his heirs and assigns forever.
All that certain lot of land, situate in the City of Greenville, in the County and State aforesaid, bounded and designated as lot No. 31 of Block B, of Cagle Park as shown by plat recorded in the M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book "C" page 238 and being more fully described as follows:
Beginning at a tailow pipe on Tindal Avenue corner of lot 30 and running thence S. 0. 53 E. 157.2 feet to a tailow pipe thence N. 77-44 W. 31.8 feet to an iron pipe; thence S. 89.07 W. 30 feet to a tailow pipe; thence N. 0. 53 W. 150 feet to a tailow pipe on Tindal Avenue corner of lot 32; thence with tailow Avenue N. 89.07 E. 61 feet to the beginning corner, having one of the lots I have conveyed to me by Cagle Park Company for deed dated July 1, 1919.

Subject, however, to the following restrictions which are part of the consideration for this deed, and are made for the benefit and protection of the other lots shown on the plat above referred to which restrictions shall remain effective for a period of twenty years from the date of deed to William Goldsmith, W. H. Workman and Walter W. Goldsmith from Cagle Park Company, to-wit:

(1) The property herein conveyed may not thereof shall not be sold, rented nor otherwise disposed of to me or my

(2) The said property shall not be used for any unlawful business nor for any thing which would constitute a nuisance, (3) The property herein conveyed shall not be cut from subdivision road to face any other direction than as shown on said plat,

(4) No building shall be erected upon said property until in twenty-five (25) feet of the present line of the avenues above mentioned

(5) No building costing less than Twenty-five Hundred (\$2500.00) Dollars shall be erected upon said lots other than out-buildings appurtenant to a dwelling.

Subject, however, to the claim of one certain Mortgage over the above described lot, executed by William Goldsmith, W. H. Workman, and Walter W. Goldsmith, to secure the payment of the sum of One Thousand (\$1,000) Dollars, with interest at six percent (6%) from July 1, 1919, said Mortgage dated July 1, 1919 and recorded in the M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Vol. 6, page 162, and as a part of this consideration for this deed the said grantee P. F. Coyle does hereby expressly assume the said mortgage and the mortgage debt together with interest thereon from July 1, 1919 until paid.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining, TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said P. F. Coyle, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND we, the undersigned, do hereby bind

heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said P. F. Coyle, his

heirs and assigns, against and

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
