KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That We, J.P. Ables and W.E. Rasor

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and twenty-five DOLLARS, to WE in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by Rebecca C. Martin

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said Rebecca C. Martin, her heirs and assigns, all that lot of land situate in the State and County aforesaid, fronting Riverside Drive and known and designated as Lot No. 29, as shown by plat of the property of Ables and Rasor, recorded in Plat Book E., page 153, and has such courses and distances as are shown on said plat, to which reference is made as a part of this description.

Upon the following conditions, which conditions are subsequent, to wit:- That no dwelling shall be erected thereon costing less than Four thousand Dollars; that no building shall be erected thereon nearer than forty feet from the property line on the Drive, and it shall not be let or sold to any person of African descent.

AND We do hereby bind

ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Rebecca C. Martin, her

heirs and assigns, against
