

Andrew B. Neely DEED TO H. C. Harrison

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Andrew B. Neely, of the County of Greenville, and

in the State aforesaid, in consideration of the sum of Ten (\$10.00) dollars and other valuable considerations DOLLARS to myself in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by H. C. Harrison

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, sell and Release unto the said

H. C. Harrison his heirs and assigns forever. All that certain piece, parcel and tract of land, lying being and situate in the County and State aforesaid, on branch of Langston Creek, waters of Reedy river, containing thirty-nine and one-fourth (39 1/4) acres, more or less, and bounded as follows: Beginning on stone 37 thence S. 33 1/2 E. 32.00 chains to a stone 37; thence S. 47 1/2 W. 7.25 chains to a stone 37; thence N. 60 W. 26.80 chains to a stone 37; thence N. 50 E. 7.95 chains to a stone 37; thence up the meandering of a branch on the beginning corner. Being the tract of land conveyed to Margaret Ann Neely by Abraham Neely, deceased, executor of the estate of Samuel Neely, de ceased, being recorded in the office of the R. M. C. for Greenville County in Book S. L. S., page 97. And being the same tract of land conveyed to me, the said Andrew B. Neely by J. W. Gray, Master, by deed dated November 9, 1904 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. N. T. T., page 88. And, also, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate lying and being in said County and State, about five miles North of Greenville, S. C., containing twenty (20) acres, more or less, and having the following lines, notes and bounds, to-wit: Beginning on a rock 37 N. on road and running thence N. 49 1/2 E. 78.4 to a stake on road; thence N. 34 W. 22.40 to a stake 27; thence S. 85 W. 1.20 to Sweet Gum 70; thence S. 40 W. 6.25 to Chestnut 70 (dead); thence S. 34 E. 21.60 to rock 27; the beginning corner, and being the tract of land conveyed to me by Sallie F. Earle, by deed dated November 29, 1892 and recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. C. C. C. page 634.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said H. C. Harrison, his heirs and assigns, forever.

AND I myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said H. C. Harrison, his heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
