Green, all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being corner of Oscar and Mayfield Streets, in the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat of Property of Parish & Gowers by R. C. Dalton, Engineer, dated August 1919, to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on the South West side of Oscar Street, fifty-four (54) feet from the intersection of Oscar and Mayfield Streets, joint corner of lot No. 1, and, 2, and thence with line of lot No. 2, 21' 35-08 ft. ninety and one-tenth (90.1) feet to an iron pipe on an eight foot alley, thence with said alley 21' 54-06 ft. seventy-five and two-tenths (75.2) feet to an iron pipe on Mayfield; thence with Mayfield Street N. 21° 58' E. ninety-three and four tenths (93.4) feet to an iron pipe corner Mayfield and Oscar Streets, thence with Oscar Street 21' 54-52 ft. 54 feet to the point of beginning.
