an undivided two-thirds interest and Mary R. Holliday  
an undivided one-third interest in and to, all that certain  
piece, parcel or lot of land situate, lying and being  
on the corner of Stone Ave. and Wilton Street, in the City of Greenville,  
County and State aforesaid, being known and described  
as lot No. 1, as shown on Plat recorded in R. M. C. Office  
for County in Plat Book "A" at page 89, and having the follow-  
ing metes and bounds, to wit:
