I know all men by these presents, that I, Anna Richey, of Chicago, Illinois, for and in consideration of H. T. Townes and A. P. DuBose, partners under the firm name of Townes & DuBose, Attorneys at Greenville, S.C. undertaking to prosecute an action or actions for me to obtain my share and interest in the estate of David Richey, deceased, my said deceased husband who died on or about April 24th, 1919, do hereby assign unto the said Townes & DuBose, their heirs and assigns and convey to the said Townes & DuBose, their heirs and assigns an undivided one-half interest of my share in and to all the estate of the said David Richey, deceased, consisting of three lots of land in the city of Greenville, State of South Carolina; one lot located on Glover Street of said city, one lot on Forest Street in said city and one lot in what is known as Jefferson Heights. Their undivided one-half interest in my share of said land is contingent upon their representing me to secure my interest therin either by sale of the said land through proceedings in court or action at law or by my conveying said land to any party who will buy the same, subject to their approval. I am not to be at any expense in prosecuting this action, so far as any traveling expenses that the said Townes & DuBose may incur or any personal expenses that they may incur in the prosecution of any action to recover my interest in said estate, but the regular cost of court, not including any lawyers fees are to follow the event of the action.
