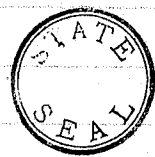

Articles of Agreement, entered into between A. L. Henderson and the Blue Ridge Cotton Oil Co. Traveler Rest, S. C.

First Party of the first part agrees to allow the said Oil Mill to use the water privilege which it now has in the pasture near the said Oil Mill, for a consideration of five dollars a year, for a period of ten years from date Jan. 1st 1921. and the said Oil Mill agrees to pay same and keep up water lines and use place for pump house and barrel in said Branch, for above stated period.
