 Saluda River, containing Fifteen acres more or less,
 having the following boundaries; Beginning on rock
 (George Earle corner) on the Caesars Head road,
 thence down said road to a Black Gum; thence
 west to Hog Branch to a Maple corner; thence up
 Hog Branch to a White Oak, thence East with William
 McJunkins line to the beginning corner.
 Together with all and singular the rights mentioned
 to the said land belonging or in anywise appertaining
 to have and to hold all and singular the said
 premises unto the said William McJunkin his
 heirs and assigns forever. And I do hereby bind
 myself, my Heirs Executors, and Administrators to
 warrant and forever defend all and singular the
 said land and premises unto the said William
 McJunkin his heirs and assigns against my-
 self and my heirs and all other persons whomso-
 ever lawfully claiming or to claim any part
 thereof.

 thence down Hog Branch to a White Oak on a Cliff,
 thence a strait line, North East course to the beginning
 corner.
