"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Chick Springs Township, County of  
Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and in the town of Taylors, and being known and  
designated as Lot No. 31 on a subdivision of Lot No. 2, property of W.M. Shockley, deceased,  
as shown by subdivision and plat of same made by Thos. T. Linder Nov. 10, 1921, and recorded  
in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book F, at page 20. Said  
lot contains 1 acre and has a frontage of 1.53 chs. on public road, known as Ridge or Coth-  
ren or Walker Road, and runs back in parallel lines 6.35 chs. and is 1.53 chs. in the rear".
