WHEREAS, Florence A. Shockley, as Administratrix of the estate of T.H. Shockley, and in her own right, et al.

on or about the 16th day of November in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-one exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against Thelma Shockley, et al.

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint; and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the 19th day of December 1921, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Beattie Smith for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No.)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, and upon receipt of \$580.00 HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said

Beattie Smith and his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate: "All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situated in Chick Springs Township, County of Greenville, and State of South Carolina, and in the Town of Taylors, and being known and designated as Lot No. 28 on a subdivision of Lot No. 2, property of W.M. Shockley, deceased as shown by subdivision and Plat of same made by Thos. T. Linder, Nov. 10, 1921 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid, in Plat Book "F", at page 29. This Lot contains 5.80 acres, more or less, and is more particular described as follows: Beginning at the South east corner of Lot No. 27 and running thence S. 88 E. along the line of Lot No. 27, 5.82; thence S. 1-1/2 W. 8.90 to point in line of Perry Edwards land; thence along the Edwards line N. 64 W. 1.18; thence continuing along the Edwards line N. 70-3/4 W. 4.94 to corner of lot No. 33; thence along the line of lots 33 and 32, N. 1-1/2 E. 11.20 to the beginning corner". Reference is hereby craved to the plat above referred to for a more particular description of said lot.
