I, E. Inman
Master in and for the County aforesaid, SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, Quintess A. Greene, E. H. Greene and Mrs. Emma Greene

on or about the 8th day of April in the year of our Lord nineteen hundred and twenty-five exhibited their complaint in the Court of Common Pleas, for the County aforesaid, against

Ruth Greene, Ora Greene, Gladys Greene and Alene Greene

demanding relief as to the real estate described in the complaint: and the cause being at issue, came on to be heard on the

day of June, 1925, and such proceedings were had therein as resulted in a decree of the said Court, whereby it was adjudged and decreed that the said real estate hereinafter mentioned and described, be conveyed by E. Inman

Master in and for the County aforesaid, to Ruth Greene for the purposes mentioned in the said decree, as by reference thereto on file in said Court, will appear; (See Judgment Roll No. 6-15-68)

NOW, Therefore, Know all Men by these Presents, that I, E. Inman Master, in and for the County of Greenville aforesaid, by virtue of the aforesaid decree, HAVE GRANTED, conveyed and released, and by these presents, DO GRANT, convey and release unto the said Ruth Greene

and her heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate:

All that certain tract or parcel of land in said county and state near the town of Paris and situate on near the right of the Farmers "Camp Sevier" and being known and designated as Tract No. 4 of the G. A. Greene estate, as shown on a sub-division and plat of same made by W. A. Hester, Surveyor, April 24, 1925, and having the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, as shown on said plat, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin N. M. at the southwest corner of said tract this being the southwest corner of Tract No. 2 and in line of land of J. R. Cole and running thence along the line of tract No. 2 N. 31° E. 8.70 to an iron pin at corner of tract No. 3; thence along the line of tract No. 3 N. 42° E. 29.90 to an iron pin N. M. thence N. 77° W. 4.90 to an iron pin; thence N. 31° E. 6.00 to a stake by W. O. Thomas N. 78 1/4 W. 6.76 to an iron pin; thence S. 34° W. 6.09 to an iron pin in road; thence S. 29 3/4 W. 6.80 to an iron pin; thence S. 19 1/4 W. 5.50 to Wild Cherry; thence S. 51 1/4 W. 9.65 to iron pin; thence S. 87 1/4 E. 4.45 to iron pin; thence S. 23 W. 9.40 to iron pin; thence N. 80 3/4 W. 3.80 to a point in the Rutherford Road; thence along said road S. 133 1/4 W. 10.90 to an iron pin; thence S. 77 1/2 W. 22.25 to an iron pin at the beginning corner and containing 80 acres more or less and a part of the land owned by G. A. Greene at the time of his death.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the premises before mentioned, unto the said Ruth Greene and her heirs and assigns forever.
