KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Bob L. Pace and Cora Pace, his wife, of the County of Park, and State of North Carolina, in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred and Fifty (\$350.00) DOLLARS, to them in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by G. P. Pace, of the County of Park, and State of North Carolina, (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

G. P. Pace, all of these two tracts, pieces or parcels of land situated in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina and described as follows: (1) Beginning on a post oak running southwest 32 poles to a black pine; thence west 16 poles to a black gum; thence north 31 poles to a maple; thence east 33 poles to the beginning corner containing three acres, more or less. (2) Adjoining lands of G. P. Pace, beginning at a stake on roadside; thence south 72 1/2' 33 poles to 3 maples; thence N. 21 1/2' W. 16 poles to a stake; thence N. 45 E. 36 poles, or about, that to a compass by roadside; thence with road, a south east course 47 poles to a stake the beginning corner, containing 4, the same more or less.

The first of the above described tracts of land was conveyed to said Bob L. Pace by deed from R. P. Pace, dated the 29th day of May 1914 and the second of said described tract was conveyed to said Bob L. Pace by deed from Rufus Heathley and wife, dated the first day of April 1911.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said G. P. Pace, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

AND WE do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said G. P. Pace, his

heirs and assigns, against us, and our heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
