all that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.  
Near the City of Greenville in the subdivision known as "Kanatae's Lot No. 1 of Block F" on the revised plat of the said property to be recorded in R. M. C. Office of said County.  
The said lot having the following metals and bounds,  
beginning at an iron pin on the North side of  
Buckton Street, and running thence along said  
street N. 55-56 E. 60.5 feet to a stake at corner of  
lot #2, thence along said lot 200 feet to a stake

will not construct on said lot any surface closet nor  
toilet, but only septic tanks or such other sanitary  
privy as may be provided by said grantee.  
This restriction is for the benefit of the other lots in  
this subdivision.

do hereby bind warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said Mrs. Etta May Barrett and her  
heirs and assigns, against me and my heirs, and every other  
person whomsoever lawfully claiming, or to claim, the same, or any part thereof.
