All that piece parcel or lot of land in the city of Greenville in ward 5 of said city on the south back side of Beach street and having the following metes and bounds according to a survey made April 1923 by C. F. Putman, Engineer, to wit: Beginning at an iron pin on Beach street 212.50 feet from the corner Birnie Beach streets and running thence S. 59° 30' E. 150 ft with line of J. T. Southern Est. to F. C. Green's line thence with said last mentioned line and parallel with Beach S. 30° 30' W. 37.5 feet to iron pin thence N. 59° 30' W. 150 ft across, lot #12 as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book A at page 159 to iron pin on Beach street thence with said street N. 30° 30' W. 37.5 feet to the beginning corner and being a portion of lots #11 and 12 on the above named plat.
