

Exchange Permit.

Received of the Southern Bell Telephone and Telegraph Company One Dollar in consideration of which I hereby grant unto said Company, its successors and assigns, the right, privilege and authority to construct, operate and maintain its lines of telephone and telegraph, including the necessary aerial cable, poles, wires and fixtures, upon and over the property which I own, or in which I have an interest, located in the Block bounded by Crescent, Jones & Capers Aves. in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville and State of S.C., said sum is received in full payment of said rights.

The Company agrees to re-locate on said property its line and fixtures to conform with future building improvements. This right permits line and fixtures across rear property at location agreed upon.
