This momorandum of agreement made and entered into this the 31st day of March by and between A. Horowitz hereinafter called the landlord and S.C. McDaniel, hereinafter called the tonant, Witnesseth:

The Landlord does by these presents rents and lease unto the said S.C. McDaniel about forty-one acres of land about seven miles from the City of Greenville, S.C., on the Spartenburg Road for the year 1922, the landlord to receive one third of all crops grown on the said place with the exception of what may be grown on about one-fourth of an acre to be used for a garden and a water melon patch, the landlord to furnish the fertilizer and the tenant to pay two-thirds of same, the tenant to plant not less than 15 acres in cotton and not less than 15 acres in corn; the landlord to furnish and advance to the tenant the sum of \$150.00 to be used in the cultivation of the said crops, at times \$10.00 per week and not more than \$15.00 per week at any time, and the tenant to pay interest on the money so advance at the rate of eight per cent per annum. The tenant agrees to keep the place in good repairs and not to cut any timber without the written consent of the landlord.

The tenant agrees to deliver all rents to the landlord at Greenville upon the request of the landlord.

All of the above is agreed to before signing.
