Newby her certain deed in writing bearing date the - - - - - -day of December, 1913, and recorded in the office of the Register of Mesne Conveyances for said County and State in Deed Book 23, at page 508, thereby conveying a certain tract of land situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville, in Bates Township, about eleven or twelve miles from Greenville Court House, on the White Horse Road and Finlay Bridge Road, adjoining lands of V.W. McCarrell, Elizabeth-Bates, I.K. Phillips and others; being a part of the land conveyed to Mrs.Nesbitt by her father George W. McCarrell (now deceased) by deed bearing date January 2, 1895, and recorded in said office in Deed Book "BBB", at page 189;

And Whereas, the tract of land conveyed by the deed first hereinabove referred to was not described therein by courses and distances; and the number of acres contained therein was not stated; but the said tract was described therein as having such metes and bounds as were shown in a plat made by W.A. Hester, bearing date December 3, 1913; but said plat was not recorded;

And Whereas, the said William T. Newby conveyed his undivided interest in said land to Miss Lillie-C. Newby by his deed bearing date September 18, 1915, and recorded in said office in Deed Book 35, at page 183, which deed did not contain any more definite description of said land than the first above mentioned;

And Whereas, the said Lillie C. Newby subsequently married and is now Mrs.Lillie Newby Batson;

Now, therefore, in order to place on the public records a correct description of said lamis, it is

hereby agreed by and between the said Carrie H. Nesbitt and Lillie Newby Batson that the following

is a correct description of the tract of land conveyed by the deed first above mentioned, to-wit:-

Beginning at a stake in the center of the White Horse Road, on corner of Ebenezer School land, and running thence along line of A.F. Jordan's land S. 76° W. 26.56 chains to post oak X30m; thence N. 59- $\frac{1}{4}$ ° W. 17.50 chains to a hickory x30m; there along line of land formerly belonging to I.K. Phillips N. $62-\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 11.45 chains to a post oak xx30m; thence S. 3/4° W. 7.50 chains to post oak 3x0m; thence S. $89-\frac{1}{2}$ ° W. 11.30 chains to stone om; there along line of land belonging to Mrs. Elizabeth Bates (formerly belonging to Mrs.F. Jane Whitmire) S. $36-\frac{1}{4}$ ° E.
