Geer covenants and agrees with The Carolina Air Transport, Inc., that it shall not be liable to him or any of his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, or to any other person, by reason of anything whatsoever growing out of, or arising out of, the operation of said air plane or planes by the said George M. Geer, now shall it be liable to any person who may be riding with the said George M. Geer, he expressly hereby covenanting and agreeing to save harmless the said The Carolina Air Transport, Inc., from any and all damages, couses of action, or any thing whatsoever arising from or growing out of his operation of said air planes for said period aforesaid.
