Memorandum of Agreement entered into this 27th day of April, A.D. 1923, by and between the City Garage, a partnership composed of L. W. Hughes and M. F. Justice, of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, hereinafter sometimes referred to as the Party of the First Part, and J. D. Robins, of the City of Greenville, County and State aforesaid, hereinafter sometimes referred to as the Party of the Second Part, Witnesseth:

1. In consideration of the sum of Five (\$5.00) Dollars, by each party hereto in hand paid by the other (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) it is mutually agreed as follows:

2. The party of the first part does hereby agree to give unto the party of the second part the exclusive selling rights and full control of the sale of an automobile appliance known as the "Master Timer" in all Counties of South Carolina West of and including the Counties of York, Chester, Fairfield, Newberry, Saluda and Edgefield, excepting only the County of Greenville, it being understood that the said party of the second part, J. D. Robins, is to receive as compensation for his services fifty (50) per cent. of all profits derived in said territory from the sale of said Master Timer. It is further agreed that this Contract shall be of force and effect for a period of one year from this date, to wit: from April 27th, 1923 to April 27th, 1924. The parties mutually agree that should the said J. D. Robins desire to renew this Contract for a like period upon the same terms at its expiration, he shall have and is hereby given that privilege.

3. In consideration of the above, the party of the second part agrees to take charge of said sales of said appliance in said territory in a salesman-like manner.

4. The party of the first part further agrees as follows, that it will keep on hand in Greenville, S.C. a stock of said timers sufficient to supply at all times the said party of the second part in order
