Fifth: That no use shall be made of the said lot, or any part thereof which would constitute a nuisance or injure the value of any of the neighboring lots.

Sixth: That in breach of any of the conditions hereinabove mentioned the said lot of land herein conveyed shall revert to the grantors, their heirs and assigns.

Together with all and singular the Rights, Members, Dependencies and Appurtenances to the said Premises belonging or in anywise incident or appertaining.

To Have and to Hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the Grantee hereinabove named, and her heirs and assigns forever.

And I do hereby bind myself, my successors, my heirs, Executrix and Administrators to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said Premises unto the said Grantee hereinabove named, her heirs and assigns, against me and my successors, my Heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming unto claim the same or any part thereof.
