M. Wharton as shown in a plat book F. at page 206 according to a survey made by R. G. Dalton in 1917 and revised for 1923 as Lot "32" and having the following metes and bounds, Commencing at a stake on the National Highway Corner Lots 30 & 32 running N. 8-15 W. 242.5 feet to a stake at the corner of said lot and the Piedmont and Northern Bury right-of-way, thence N. 61-07 E. 54.5 feet along the said right-of-way to a stake corner Lots 32 & 34 thence S. 8-15 E. 265.2 feet to a stake on the National Highway Corner Lots 32 & 34 thence along said highway S. 81-48 W. 50 feet to the beginning corner.
