(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said L. C. Ashmore

All that certain triangular strip of land situate, lying and being in Greenville Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on the Eastern side of the Grove Road and having according to a survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer December 1923, the following metes and bounds to wit: Beginning at an iron pipe on the Eastern side of Grove Road, corner of L. C. Ashmore property, and running thence with his line S. 73-29 E. 136.2 feet to an iron pipe at the rear corner of Lot No. 1 of Block "N" of the O. P. Mills subdivision; thence along a new line of Catcreek Road N. 83-06 W. 149.3 feet to an iron pipe on the eastern side of Grove Road, thence N. 12-37 E. 2.5 feet to the point of beginning.

As part of the consideration for this deed, the grantee agreed that he will place at the intersection of Catcreek Road with Grove Road a concrete gutter similar in every respect to that now at the intersection of Elm Street and Grove Road and that he will relocate the sidewalk on Catcreek Road so as to conform with the new line of Catcreek Road and that he will grade Catcreek Road as agreed upon by him and certain property owners on Catcreek Road.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said L. C. Ashmore, his

heirs and assigns, forever.

And

do hereby bind

him, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said

heirs and assigns, against

him, and against every person whom ever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof,
