to and in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the  
said E. M. Jones his heirs and assigns forever,

All our right title and interest, of in and to  
all that certain lot of land situated lying and being  
in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid  
on the Northern side of East North Street, in Ward  
Two of said City, and having the following metes  
and bounds, corners and distances, to wit:  
Beginning at a point on the Northern side of  
East North Street at the Southwestern bank of  
Richland Creek and thence running along North  
Street N. 47 E. to a point in the center of Richland  
Creek thence up the center of Richland  
Creek following the meanders thereof to the corner
