Boone, all of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situated, lying and being in Gates Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres, more or less, and has such shape, marks and boundaries as follows: beginning at a stake in the White Horse Road, and running thence N. 45° E. 2.90 to bend in road; thence N. 45° E. 4.74 to stake in said road (White Horse); thence N. 54° E. 6.50 to Cherry (stone); thence N. 23° W. 24.50 to stone on; thence N. 35° W. 23.00 to stone on; thence S. 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 13.65 to iron pin in settlement road; thence with said road S. 79° E. 3.18 to bend; thence S. 45° E. 3.00 to bend; thence S. 39° E. 3.88 to bend; thence N. 74° E. 5.65 to bend; thence S. 66° E. 2.72 to iron pin in said road; thence S. 2° E. 6.56 to stone on; thence N. 71 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 11.20 to a poplar stump; thence S. 29 $\frac{1}{2}$ E. 3.20 to the beginning corner.
