to the said Estate & Investment Company, in hand paid at and before the sealing of these presents by the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have Granted, Bargained, Sold, and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Estate & Investment Company: - All that certain piece, parcel, or tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, about three miles northeast of the City of Greenville, and being a part of the Davis Survey tract, and known according to a plat thereof prepared by J. O. Poteat Company, the following lines and boundaries, to wit: Beginning at an iron post in the center of Franklin Road, and running along said post to the corner of the County Court property, which is now owned by the Franklin River and running thence with Franklin Road, the following courses and distances: S. 87-38 E. 190.5 feet to a point; thence S. 48-38 E. 100 feet to a point; thence S. 41-16 E. 180 feet to a point; thence S. 33-28 E. 100 feet to a point; thence S. 22-47 E. 159 feet to a point; thence bearing Franklin Road, S. 21-12 E. 32.6 feet to a point; thence bearing the Shackleton property, thence S. 81-28 W. 34.9 feet to an iron post in Old Country Club line, and thence with the Old Country Club line, N. 8-17 W. 3-98.9 feet to the point of beginning; and containing 3.33 acres, more or less.
