Lipscomb their heirs and assigns forever All my right title and interest the same being an undivided one eighth interest, in and to all that certain tract of land partly within and partly without the city limits of Greenville lying north of the said City of Greenville and bounded by lands now or formerly of W. H. Irvin and G. A. Woodward on the north; C. B. Stone and Stone Land Company on the east; by Davis Avenue on the south and W. S. Davis on the west.
