page 373, in the office of the Register of Deeds Conveyance  
for Greenville County, South Carolina.

The following restrictions are hereby made with this conveyance

African descent and that the main dwelling herein, or  
any future main dwelling, shall not be rented, leased  
or otherwise tenanted by the same; That there shall be no  
nuisance allowed on this property. That the front wall of any  
building on this property shall not be closer to the street  
than twenty feet. That no main dwelling shall be  
erected on this property which shall cost less than \$2500.00  
This conveyance is made subject to a mortgage in the  
sum of approximately \$2765.00 held by the Wilmington Savings  
Bank & Trust Co. which mortgage the grantee herein hereby  
assumes.

TOGETHER with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said Premises belonging, or in anywise incident or  
appertaining.
