at and before the sealing of these presents by *Rebecca J. Pector*

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said

Rebecca J. Pector her heirs and assigns forever:
all that certain piece parcel or tract of land situated
lying and being in the County and State aforesaid
on South side of Middle Tiger River, and being
known as the Nathaniel Pector Homestead and de-
scribed as used from Nathaniel Pector to Rebecca J.
Pector as follows, to-wit: Beginning on a Spanish
corner, Jimmy Ballenger's corner, thence N. 14 1/2 W. 45
feet to a rock, the bear den in the head of the
rock, thence E. 26 chs. to a white oak; thence
S. 76 chains to a white oak corner of vacant
land of fourteen acres; land added to the home
tract, thence N. 3 W. 31 chs. to a hickwood knot, corner
at E. W. Center's; thence S. 19 chs. to a glass oak; thence
N. 67 E. 38.50 chs. to the beginning corner, containing
12 acres, more or less, did being the same tract
of land conveyed by Nathaniel Pector to Rebecca J.
Pector by deed dated June 8th 1874.

Also all that other certain piece, parcel or tract of
land situate, lying and being in the County and
State aforesaid, adjoining the above described land
containing seven acres, more or less, and being described
as follows, to-wit:

Beginning on a chestnut, corner on Ballenger's line
thence with Robert Thompson's line to a rock 33, thence
in a straight line in a northwest course to a stone
at the head of a hollow; thence in a north course
to a rock at the head of a hollow; thence in a
west course to a rock on Pector's line near the
mouth of the lake; thence with his line to a rock
Ballenger's corner; thence with Ballenger's line to the
beginning, and being the same tract of land conveyed
to Rebecca J. Pector by Sarah Farmer by deed dated
April 3rd 1877.

conveyed to me by Rebecca J. Pector by deed dated
