in consideration of the sum of

at and before the sealing of these presents by S. Miles Mcbee

(the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Released, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Release unto the said Victor M. Baker all that lot or parcel of land situate lying and being on the N. side of Mailard Street in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid and being known and designated as Lot No 12, as shown on the revised plat made by C. M. Purman, Jr. C. E. which plat is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book C page 62 and having according to said plat, the following notes and bounds, to wit;  
Beginning at an iron pin on the N. side of Mailard street the front corner of lots Nos 11 & 12 and running thence with the front line of said lots N. 71-41 W. 187-4 ft. to an iron pin on a 16.5 ft. alley thence along the eastern side of said alley S. 18-39 W. 67 ft. to an iron pin, corner of lot 11-12 as recorded; thence with the line of that lot S. 71-41 E. 185.5 ft. to an iron pin on the N. side of Mailard street, thence with the western side of said street N. 20-32 E. 67 ft. to the point of beginning.

Reserving the right to the City of Greenville to bridge over the alley above mentioned in the event that the City of Greenville shall extend its buildings over lots Nos 11 & 12, as shown on said plat. However, in the event that such bridging over is done the City of Greenville shall leave sufficient space beneath such bridge for vehicles to pass in and out of said alley.

TOGETHER with, all and singular, the rights, members, hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging, or in anywise incident or appertaining.  
TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular, the said premises before mentioned, unto the said Victor M. Baker,

heirs and assigns, forever.

himself, executors and administrators, to warrant and forever defend, all and singular, the said premises unto the said Victor M. Baker,

heirs, and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same, or any part thereof.
